Notice concerning GRESB Real Estate Assessment Results

Invincible Investment Corporation ("INV") announces the 2022 GRESB Real Estate Assessment as follows.

1. Assessment Results

In the 2022 GRESB Real Estate Assessment, INV received a "2-Star" GRESB Rating, which is based on overall GRESB scores and its quintile position among participants. INV was also awarded a "Green Star" designation for the second consecutive year by achieving high performance in both the "Management Component" that evaluates policies and organizational structure for ESG (Environmental, Social, and Governance) promotion, and the "Performance Component" that assesses environmental performance and tenant engagement of properties owned.

Further, INV was highly evaluated for its ESG information disclosure efforts and received an "A Level" the highest level for GRESB Public Disclosure for the second consecutive year, which assesses the breadth of ESG disclosure.

(Reference) Overview of the GRESB Real Estate Assessment

GRESB is an annual benchmarking assessment to measure ESG integration of real estate companies and funds. It was founded in 2009 by a group of major European pension funds who played leading roles in launching Principles for Responsible Investment (PRI). Currently, 170 Investor Members (with more than USD 51 trillion in assets under management) use GRESB data for their investment decision-making and engagement with investees, and several institutions from Japan including Government Pension Investment Fund (GPIF) utilize GRESB Assessment results.

The GRESB Real Estate Assessment is characterized by evaluating sustainability initiatives of real estate companies, REITs, and real estate funds, rather than targeting individual real estate. In 2022, 1,820 listed or private real estate companies/funds participated in the GRESB Real Estate Assessment.
